What You Will Learn

Learning online gives you the flexibility to continue your education, allowing you to balance school, career and personal commitments. This program is available to students with no prior health care education experience and also to those who want to continue their education.

Applicants can apply for a transfer option to accelerate into semester III of the five-semester program by transferring up to 28 credits under the following conditions: 12 of the 28 transfer credits must be from a health care field with a grade of "C" or better.

Pima Medical Institute certificate graduates can transfer into semester III from the following programs: Dental Assistant, Health Care Administration Certificate, Medical Assistant, Medical Billing and Coding, Patient Care Technician, Pharmacy Technician, Sterile Processing Technician.

Job Outlook

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment of medical and health services managers is projected to grow 32 percent from 2020 to 2030, much faster than the average for all occupations. As the large baby-boom population ages and people remain active later in life, there should be increased demand for healthcare services.*

Employment

Health care leaders and managers can expect to find employment in hospitals, clinics, outpatient care sites, physicians' offices and even health management companies, which provide management services to hospitals and other organizations, as well as to specific departments, such as emergency, information management systems, managed care contract negotiations and physician recruiting.


