





RESPIRATORY THERAPY Specialize in prevention, diagnosis, treatment, management and rehabilitation of patients with breathing or other cardiopulmonary disorders.

- Provide treatment that can range from giving emergency relief to patients with respiratory disorders to long-term care for chronic conditions such as COPD or Cystic Fibrosis
- Manage and master life-saving devices such as mechanical ventilators and non-invasive machines
- Develop the clinical skills to manage respiratory disorders in a variety of patient populations from premature babies to geriatrics
- Administer breathing treatments and other adjunct therapies to improve lung function
- Educate patients about their condition and how to properly use medication and equipment
