In 1990, Congress enacted the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act (Title II of Public Law 101-542), which amended the Higher Education Act of 1965 (HEA). HEA was amended in 1992, 1998 and 2000. The 1998 amendment renamed the law the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act in memory of a student who was slain in her dorm room in 1986. It is generally referred to as the Clery Act. On August 14, 2008, the Higher Education Opportunity Act or HEOA reauthorized and expanded the HEA of 1965 and the Clery Act (34 CFR 668.46), as amended in conjunction with the Violence Against Women Act signed into law by President Obama on March 7, 2013. In compliance with this legislation, Pima Medical Institute updates and publishes this report annually detailing its crime awareness policies and procedures. This report is available on the PMI website, through the Consumer Information page, and a paper copy is available upon request at each campus location.

INTRODUCTION

The following information is provided as testament to Pima Medical Institute's commitment to supporting the safety and welfare of its students, faculty, staff and visitors. While crises can occur even in the best prepared facilities, it is our goal to implement, prepare and practice for these crises in an effort to minimize negative outcomes. Pima Medical Institute has designed a Crisis Management Plan to maximize safety and survival, preserve property, minimize danger, restore normal operations, and assure responsive communications with the community and responders.

Crime Statistics

Crime statistics for each Pima Medical Institute campus will be collected and reported by the Campus Director. The data will be maintained, along with this document, and reported, as required. The institution will make a good-faith effort to collect statistics for all Clery Act crimes committed in applicable geographic locations from all law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction for this institution. These statistics are updated annually (see attachments at the end of this report for Pima Medical Institute crime statistics for the past three years, by campus, as compiled by Campus Directors from police reports in their respective jurisdiction); all students and employees will be notified of the data, and a printed copy of this information is available for review by all students, faculty, staff and visitors upon request.

Emergency Management Team Contact Information

Pima Medical Institute's Emergency Management Team consists of local campus personnel and corporate leaders. The Campus Director will serve as the Emergency Management Team Leader during a campus emergency or in the event of an alleged crime and should be contacted immediately. In case of emergency, staff and faculty shall not hesitate to activate emergency response services by calling 911.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN – Campus Policies Regarding Procedures and Reporting of Criminal Action and Other Emergencies Occurring on Campus

All students and employees are instructed, during their student/employee orientation, of the Emergency Management Plan, which includes reporting, emergency response, notification, evacuation, lockdown, and timely warning procedures.

Emergency notification and evacuation drills are conducted biannually and the school maintains documented details of these drills. Upon request, written documentation of the drills will be provided at the campus level. Please contact the campus front desk to obtain more information about specific campus annual emergency response and evacuation tests.

Reporting

Students or employees witnessing or involved in any kind of criminal action or emergency on campus shall report this event to their instructor or supervisor.

If the instructor or supervisor is unavailable, the student or employee shall report actions to any responsible staff member. All reports shall be given to the Campus Director or alternate campus Emergency Management Leader, who will implement the Emergency Management Plan as necessary. Pima Medical Institute encourages accurate and prompt reporting of all crimes to campus personnel and/or local law enforcement.

Emergency Response

Pima Medical Institute will, without delay, and taking into account the safety of the campus community, immediately notify the campus community of a significant emergency or dangerous situation involving an immediate threat to the health and/or safety of those on campus, unless the notification will, in the professional judgment of responsible authorities, compromise efforts to assist a victim or to contain, respond to, or otherwise mitigate the emergency.

The Emergency Management Leader should be immediately informed of a significant emergency or dangerous situation; personnel should not delay contacting the local emergency response system should the Emergency Management Leader be inaccessible.

Notification Procedure

- In case of emergency, 911 shall be contacted immediately.
- The employee who first learns of the significant emergency shall contact the Campus Director or alternate campus Emergency Management Leader on duty.
- The Emergency Management Leader will be responsible for implementing the Emergency Management Plan.
- The Emergency Management Leader will, upon confirmation that there is a significant emergency or dangerous situation involving an immediate threat to the health and safety of students or employees occurring on the campus, immediately notify the campus community.
- Initiation and content of the notification are the responsibility of the Emergency Management Leader.
- Notification will occur by means of audible alert, email, text messages, telephone calls or any other form of effective communication determined to best address the situation.
- If indicated, the Evacuation Plan will be implemented.
- The building will be secured and students and employees will be directed to a safe location.
- If indicated, a campus lockdown and shelter in place procedure will be implemented.
- The entire campus community will be notified of the emergency.
- The Chief Executive Officer or their designee will serve as the public information officer and be responsible for disseminating emergency information to the larger community.

Pima Medical Institute is utilizing the Omnilert notification system, which enables the Emergency Management Team Leader to initiate immediate notifications to all staff, faculty and students from their cell phone or computer. The system is tied to all student records in our database, which provides the added benefit of automatic updates to all contact information (cell phone numbers, landline numbers and emails) in real time, as students update their records.

Evacuation Plan

All students are informed of the emergency evacuation and notification process during their new student orientation and as a follow up to evacuation drills. Employees are oriented to evacuation responsibilities

during their new employee orientation and as part of a yearly Emergency Management Plan review. Evacuation routes are posted on each campus and information regarding evacuation and shelter-in-place locations.

Lockdown Procedures

The Emergency Management Plan contains a campus lockdown procedure. In the event where the Emergency Management Leader deems it necessary to put the building into lockdown, the campus will activate the campus lockdown procedure. Testing of this emergency response procedure will be conducted and recorded no less than on a biannual basis.

Timely Warning

Timely warnings of emergency conditions are essential to preserve the safety and security of the school community and critical to an effective response and recovery. In the event that a situation arises, either on or off campus, that, in the judgment of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Chief Operating Officer (COO), Regional Director of Operations (RDO), Campus Director, and/or Emergency Management Leader, constitutes a serious, ongoing, or continuing threat, a campus wide “timely warning” will be issued. A timely warning will be issued for any reported Clery Act crimes. The method and content of the warning will be determined by the Campus Director or Emergency Management Leader and will include at minimum all information that would promote safety and aid in the prevention of similar crimes.

Anyone with information warranting a timely warning should report the circumstances to the Campus Director by phone or in person.

Testing of this emergency response procedure will be conducted and recorded at least on a biannual basis.

CRIME AWARENESS AND AVOIDANCE

Policies Concerning Security and Access to Campus Facilities

An orientation is held with new students and employees to inform them about campus security procedures and practices and to encourage them to be responsible for their own security and the security of others.

Instructors and supervisors will continue to remind students and employees of their need to remain security conscious throughout their enrollment or employment.

All normal staff and employees are to display a Pima Medical Institute ID while on campus. Any visitors to the campus must obtain a visitor badge upon arrival.

Pima Medical Institute's program to inform students and employees about crime prevention is a one-on-one instructor to student, supervisor to employee communication of the need to be security conscious.

The campus area is accessible during normal business hours. Responsible management personnel will be available during all normal business hours to ensure timely response to any and all incidents reported.

Pima Medical Institute does not own or control any housing. Students and employees are advised to inquire with apartment managers and/or local law enforcement agencies as to residence security.

Maintenance of campus facilities is considered to be of the highest priority. All campus facilities will be maintained in an effort to ensure the highest standards of safety and security.

Policies Concerning Campus Law Enforcement

Pima Medical Institute campus law enforcement is conducted by local law enforcement agencies. No written memorandum of understanding exists between Pima Medical Institute and the local law enforcement agencies. Pima Medical Institute will defer to local law enforcement agencies for investigation of alleged criminal offenses.

Students or employees who witness or are involved in any kind of criminal action or emergency and do not report the crime or emergency promptly may be subject to termination from enrollment or employment.

Pima Medical Institute has no recognized off-campus student organizations.

STUDENT AND EMPLOYEE CONDUCT

PMI enforces standards of honesty and integrity in all academic related work and does not tolerate plagiarism, intentional misrepresentation, or misconduct. The code of conduct provides a framework of responsibilities and proper practices expected for education and the health care profession. The information provided in the policy is not all inclusive and PMI reserves the right to hold accountable any student or employee who performs or displays any behavior that is not considered appropriate within the academic setting, including clinical rotations.

Students or employees who violate PMI policies, procedures, interfere with the progress of other students, or engage in any form of dishonesty, upon proof, are subject to termination from enrollment or employment. Grounds for termination include but are not limited to violation of the following:

- Sexual violence, sexual assault, sexual misconduct, harassment;
- Possession of firearms or weapons while on campus or at a clinical setting or PMI-affiliated event;
- HIPPA violations;
- Positive results for alcohol or drugs, refusal to submit to 'for cause' drug or alcohol screening, admission to using alcohol or other substances that contributed to impaired behavior witnessed at the school, at a clinical site, or any PMI-affiliated event;
- Academic dishonesty, such as plagiarism, intentional misrepresentation, or misconduct;
- Inappropriate use of social media, such as failing to comply with the copyright and fair use policy or not respecting others' privacy;
- Misrepresentation of criminal history;
- Vandalism or theft of school or student property, actions in an obscene, vulgar, or abusive manner, and/or
- Federal, state, or local laws (e.g., tampering with a fire alarm).

Policy violations are directed to campus administration for disciplinary action. Students who have been terminated due to policy violations may appeal under the provisions of the PMI grievance procedure. Refunds made to students who have been terminated are subject to the terms of the enrollment agreement.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY

The Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1989 requires institutions receiving federal funds or financial assistance to establish and enforce a program to prevent the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs, prescription medications, and alcohol by students, and employees. The program includes a description of the health risks associated with the use of illicit drugs and alcohol, standards of conduct, sanctions under federal, state, local law, and campus policy, information on preventing drug and alcohol abuse, and available counseling and treatment options.

Health Risks

Information about drugs of abuse uses and effects is available through the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration and may be viewed [HERE](#).

The use of illicit drugs and alcohol erodes the capacity to perform, think, and act responsibly. Long-term drug abuse can have a profound effect on a person's health and well-being. Any form of such substance abuse is considered to create an extreme danger in the school to both students and others and it can be grounds for termination of enrollment or employment at this institution.

All students and employees are hereby notified that the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of drugs and alcohol is prohibited on this institution's premises and during school-related tasks or functions. These "premises" are defined as all school property including building interiors and exteriors, common areas, sidewalks, parking lots, privately owned vehicles parked in the school parking lot, as well as desks, cabinets and storage areas. This prohibition applies to students and PMI employees performing any school related task, clinical externship, or attending any school sponsored function including field trips regardless of location on or off school premises.

Sanctions

PMI will impose sanctions on students and employees for violations of the drug and alcohol standards of conduct consistent with federal, state, local law, and campus policy. Consistent with the severity of the violation, sanctions may include:

- Verbal warning
- Written reprimand
- Disciplinary conduct warning
- Suspension
- Termination of enrollment

Local, state, and federal laws provide for a variety of legal sanctions and penalties for the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol. PMI enforces a "zero tolerance" policy regarding underage drinking and will enforce state underage drinking laws on its campus premises. (Note: The minimum legal drinking age in the United States is 21, with the exception that in Puerto Rico the minimum legal drinking age is 18.) The consumption and/or possession of any alcoholic beverage by any person under the age of 21 is prohibited.

State and Local Drug Possession, Use or Distribution Laws

PMI operates in states that have adopted recreational and medical marijuana laws. PMI follows these laws but does remind students that these laws do not supersede federal law or, generally, permit students or employees to be at school or in the workplace, as the case may be, in an impaired state.

Counseling and Treatment

PMI recognizes drug and alcohol dependency to be an illness and a major health problem. The institution also distinguishes drug abuse as a potential health, safety, and security problem. Students needing assistance in dealing with drug/alcohol dependency are encouraged to utilize the Student Assistance Program or make contact with campus student services who can provide confidential counseling referrals, assistance, or information.

Employees needing assistance in dealing with such problems are encouraged to utilize the Employee Assistance Program or other appropriate counseling services. Conscientious efforts to seek such help will not jeopardize employment.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE PREVENTION PROGRAM

Prevention and early intervention strategies can reduce the impact of substance abuse. PMI students and employees are provided information during orientation regarding the PMI drug and alcohol prevention program and are encouraged to seek assistance when needed. PMI will annually distribute in writing to each student and employee a description of the health risks associated with the use of illicit drugs and alcohol, standards of conduct, sanctions under federal, state, local law, and campus policy, information on preventing drug and alcohol abuse, and available counseling and treatment options.

FIREARMS AND WEAPONS POLICY

Pima Medical Institute strictly prohibits the possession of firearms and weapons on all campuses. Other than police officers or military personnel on active duty, no person, including a licensee, may possess firearms anywhere on campus, whether in a building or on the grounds. This prohibition extends to school owned and school-controlled locations, including sites leased for educational purposes.

Firearm

- Any device that shoots a bullet, pellet, tranquilizer, spear dart, paintball or other projectile, whether loaded or unloaded, including those powered by CO2.
- This includes, but is not limited to, guns, air guns, dart guns, pistols, revolvers, rifles, cannons, etc., and any ammunition for any such device.

Weapon

- Any device that is designed to or traditionally used to inflict harm. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Firearms, slingshots, switchblades, daggers, blackjacks, brass knuckles, bows and arrows, hand grenades, hunting knives, nun-chucks, throwing stars, or any object that could be reasonably construed as a weapon.

Anyone possessing a firearm or weapon will be asked to remove it from the campus or school event immediately. If the firearm and/or weapon is not immediately removed from the campus or school event, law enforcement will be notified and the emergency management procedures will be activated.

An employee aware of a violation of this policy is required to immediately notify the Campus Director or his or her direct supervisor. Any student, faculty or staff member violating this policy will be severely sanctioned, up to and including expulsion or termination. Additionally, violations of the school's Firearms and Weapons Policy may result in criminal prosecution.

HARASSMENT, VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT

It is the practice at PMI to ensure that employees and students enjoy a learning environment that is based upon mutual respect, trust, and dignity. The administration of PMI fully supports all local, state, and federal laws governing sexual violence and harassment and will cooperate to the fullest extent possible.

Harassment of any kind will not be tolerated and includes: actions, words, jokes, or comments based on an individual's gender, race, ethnicity, age, religion, disability, or any other protected status; actions intended to intimidate or cause fear; and any form of unwelcome behavior of a sexual nature including verbal, nonverbal, written, and physical actions.

Pima Medical Institute does not tolerate sexual violence in any form, including but not limited to sexual assault, rape, harassment, exploitation, intimidation, dating violence, domestic violence, and/or stalking.

PMI, in a good faith effort to comply with amendments to the *Clery Act*, as mandated by Section 304 of the *"Violence Against Women Reauthorization of 2013"*, is committed to ongoing development of prevention and awareness programs, policies and procedures.

An individual who has reason to believe that they are the victim of sexual or another form of harassment, or if any staff or students have witnessed harassment, should immediately report the incident to the Campus or Associate Campus Director in written form. An investigation will be initiated no later than five (5) business days and corrective action taken when warranted. No action will be taken against those reporting harassment, regardless of the investigation's outcome. With the alleged victim's permission, the appropriate authorities will be contacted. The campus director will conduct an additional investigation following PMI procedures. Those found to be engaging in any form of harassment will be subject to termination.

TITLE IX SEX-BASED OFFENSES REPORTING

Pima Medical Institute (PMI) does not discriminate in its admissions or employment, or in its educational programs or activities on the basis of sex.

As a recipient of Federal financial assistance for education activities, PMI is required by Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and the 2020 Amendments to the Title IX regulations, to ensure that all of its education programs and activities do not discriminate on the basis of sex. Discrimination on the basis of sex includes discrimination on the basis of sex stereotypes, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, and pregnancy or related conditions. Sex-based harassment, sexual assault, dating and domestic violence, and stalking are forms of sex discrimination, which are prohibited under Title IX and by PMI policy.

PMI will respond to any allegations of sexual harassment under Title IX so that every complainant receives appropriate support, respondents are treated as responsible only after receiving due process and fundamental fairness, and school officials serve impartially without bias for or against any party. PMI will respond when:

- the school has actual knowledge of sexual harassment;
- that occurred within the school's education program or activity;
- against a person in the United States.

Further, complainants and respondents will have strong, clear procedural rights in a predictable, transparent grievance process designed to reach reliable outcomes.

PMI will investigate every formal complaint, which may be filed by a complainant or by PMI's Title IX Coordinator. If the alleged conduct does not fall under Title IX, PMI will address the allegations under the PMI Code of Conduct and provide supportive measures, when applicable.

Definitions

- **"Complainant"** is any individual who has reported being or is alleged to be impacted by Prohibited Conduct as defined by this policy, and who was participating in a PMI program or activity at the time of the alleged misconduct.
- **"Consent"** is knowing, voluntary and mutual decision among all participants to engage in sexual activity, expressed in words or actions. For consent to be valid, there must be a clear expression in words or actions that the other individual consented to that specific sexual conduct with that particular person or people. Individuals may experience the same interaction in different ways. Therefore, it is the responsibility of each party to determine that the other has consented before engaging in the activity. If consent is not clearly provided prior to engaging in the activity, consent may be ratified by word or action at some point during the interaction or thereafter, but clear communication from the outset is strongly encouraged. Consent to some sexual contact (such as kissing or fondling) cannot be presumed to be consent for other sexual activity (such as intercourse). Past consent does not imply future consent. A current or previous dating relationship is not sufficient to constitute consent. The existence of consent is based on the totality of the circumstances, evaluated from the perspective of a reasonable person in the same or similar circumstances, including the context in which the alleged incident occurred. Silence or the absence of resistance alone is not consent. A minor (meaning a person under the age of 18 years, where applicable per state) cannot consent to sexual activity except in limited circumstances dictated by law. Consent can be withdrawn at any time during sexual activity through reasonable and clear communications through words or actions. When consent is withdrawn, sexual activity must stop.

- o **Coercion/Force:** consent cannot be procured by the use of physical force, compulsion, threats, intimidating behavior, or coercion. Sexual activity accompanied by coercion or force is not consensual.
- o **Coercion** refers to unreasonable pressure for sexual activity. When someone makes it clear that they do not want to engage in sexual activity or do not want to go beyond a certain point of sexual interaction, continued pressure beyond that point can be considered coercive. The use of coercion can involve the use of pressure, manipulation, substances, or force. Ignoring objections of another person is a form of coercion. Force refers to the use of physical violence or imposing on someone physically to engage in sexual contact or intercourse.
- o **Force** can also include threats, intimidation (implied threats), or coercion used to overcome resistance.
- o **Incapacitation:** occurs when someone cannot make rational, reasonable decisions because they lack the capacity to give knowing and informed consent (e.g., to understand the “who, what, when, where, why, and how” of their sexual interaction). Incapacitation is determined through consideration of all relevant indicators of a person’s state and is not synonymous with intoxication, impairment, or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- o This policy also covers a person whose incapacity results from temporary or permanent physical or mental health condition, involuntary physical restraint, and/or the consumption of incapacitating drugs, or who are sleeping.

Under this policy, PMI will consider whether a respondent knew or should have known the complainant to be incapacitated, based on an objective, reasonable person standard that assumes the reasonable person is both sober and exercising sound judgment. The fact that the respondent was unaware of the complainant’s incapacity due to the respondent’s own drug or alcohol use shall not be considered as an excuse.

- **Discrimination on the Basis of Sex:** Discrimination is defined as treating members of a protected category less favorably because of their actual or perceived membership in that category or as having a policy or practice that adversely impacts the members of one protected category more than others. Discrimination on the basis of sex includes discrimination on the basis of sex stereotypes, sex characteristics, pregnancy or related conditions, sexual orientation, and gender identity.
- **“Education program or activity”** includes all campus operations, including off-campus settings that are operated or overseen by Pima; conduct subject to the Pima’s disciplinary authority that occurs off-campus; conduct that takes place via Pima-sponsored electronic devices, computer and internet networks and digital platforms operated by, or used in the operations of, the Pima. Conduct that occurs outside of the education program or activity may contribute to a hostile environment within the program or activity.
- **“Equal access to program or activity.”** Signs of enduring unequal educational access due to severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive sexual harassment may include: skipping class to avoid a harasser, a decline in a student’s grade point average, or having difficulty concentrating in class.
- **“Prohibited Conduct”** means the conduct prohibited by this policy. Prohibited Conduct includes sex discrimination, including sex-based harassment, and retaliation.
- **“Reporting Party”** means person reporting an incident that was witnessed or received the information about the incident and is reporting it to the appropriate PMI person.
- **“Respondent”** any individual who has been reported to be the perpetrator of conduct

that could constitute sexual harassment.

- **“Retaliation”** is any materially adverse action taken against an individual because they were involved in the disclosure, reporting, investigation, or resolution of a report of Prohibited Conduct. Retaliation includes threats, intimidation, harassment, coercion, discrimination, violence, or any other conduct against any person by PMI, a student, or an employee or other person authorized by PMI to provide aid, benefit, or service under PMI’s education program or activity, for the purpose of interfering with any right or privilege secured by this policy or by law, including Title IX or its regulations. Adverse action does not include perceived or petty slights, or trivial annoyances.
 - The prohibition against retaliation applies to any individuals who participate (or refuse to participate) in any manner in an investigation, or hearing, and to any student who refuses to participate in an investigation, proceeding, or hearing.
 - Retaliation may occur even where there is a finding of “not responsible” under this policy. Good faith actions lawfully pursued in response to a report of Prohibited Conduct are not Retaliation.
- **“Sex-based Harassment”** is a form of sex discrimination and means sexual harassment and other harassment on the basis of sex, including on the basis of sex stereotypes, sex characteristics, pregnancy or related conditions, sexual orientation, and gender identity. Sex-Based Harassment includes the following:
 - **Quid pro quo harassment:** An employee, agent, or other person authorized by PMI to provide an aid, benefit, or service under PMI’s education program or activity explicitly or impliedly conditioning the provision of such an aid, benefit, or service on a person’s participation in unwelcome sexual conduct.
 - **Hostile environment harassment:** Unwelcome sex-based conduct that, based on the totality of the circumstances, is subjectively and objectively offensive and is so severe or pervasive that it limits or denies a person’s ability to participate in or benefit from PMI’s education program or activity (i.e., creates a hostile environment). Whether a hostile environment has been created is a fact-specific inquiry that includes consideration of the following:
 - The degree to which the conduct affected the complainant’s ability to access PMI’s education program or activity;
 - The type, frequency, and duration of the conduct;
 - The parties’ ages, roles within PMI’s education program or activity, previous interactions, and other factors about a party that may be relevant to evaluating the effects of the conduct;
 - The location of the conduct and the context in which the conduct occurred; and
 - Other sex-based harassment in PMI’s education program or activity.
 - Additional sexual harassment definitions from state workplace law.
- **Sexual Assault:** an offense classified as a forcible or nonforcible sex offense under the uniform crime reporting system of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Specifically, this includes:
 - **Rape**—The penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim.

- **Fondling**—The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification, without the consent of the victim, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of their age or because of their temporary or permanent mental incapacity.
- **Incest**—Sexual intercourse between persons who are related to each other within the degrees wherein marriage is prohibited by law.
- **Statutory Rape**—Sexual intercourse with a person who is under the statutory age of consent.
- **Dating violence:** violence committed by a person:
 - Who is or has been in a social relationship of a romantic or intimate nature with the victim; and
 - Where the existence of such a relationship shall be determined based on a consideration of the following factors:
 - The length of the relationship;
 - The type of relationship; and
 - The frequency of interaction between the persons involved in the relationship.
 - Emotional and psychological abuse do not constitute violence for the purposes of this definition.
- **Domestic violence:** felony or misdemeanor crimes of violence committed by a person who:
 - Is a current or former spouse or intimate partner of the victim under the family or domestic violence laws of the jurisdiction of PMI, or a person similarly situated to a spouse of the victim;
 - Is cohabitating, or has cohabitated, with the victim as a spouse or intimate partner;
 - Shares a child in common with the victim; or
 - Commits acts against a youth or adult victim who is protected from those acts under the family or domestic violence laws of the jurisdiction.
 - Emotional and psychological abuse do not constitute violence for the purposes of this definition.
- **Stalking:** Engaging in a course of conduct, on the basis of sex, directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person to fear for the person’s safety or the safety of others; or suffer substantial emotional distress.
- **Sexual coercion:** The application of unreasonable pressure, including emotionally or physically manipulative actions or statements, or direct or implied threats, in order to compel the person to engage in sexual activity.
- **Sexual exploitation** means a person taking sexual advantage of another person for the benefit of anyone other than that person without that person’s consent, including, but not limited to, any of the following acts:
 - The prostituting of another person;
 - The trafficking of another person, defined as the inducement of a person to perform a commercial sex act, or labor or services, through force, fraud, or coercion;
 - The recording of images, including video or photograph, or audio of another person’s sexual activity or intimate parts, without that person’s consent;
 - The distribution of images, including video or photograph, or audio of another person’s sexual activity or intimate parts, if the individual distributing the images or audio knows or should have known that the person depicted in the images or

- audio did not consent to the disclosure.
- The viewing of another person’s sexual activity or intimate parts, in a place where that other person would have a reasonable expectation of privacy, without that person’s consent, for the purpose of arousing or gratifying sexual desire.
- **“Sexual misconduct”** Includes sexual harassment, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking.
- **“PMI Community”** includes PMI employees, students, clinical related school officials (e.g., clinical instructor, clinical coordinator).

Title IX Investigations

PMI will investigate and adjudicate formal complaints of sexual harassment using a grievance process that incorporates due process principles, treats all parties fairly, and reaches reliable responsibility determinations.

PMI’s grievance process gives both parties written notice of the allegations, an equal opportunity to select an advisor of the party’s choice, and an equal opportunity to submit and review evidence throughout the investigation.

Additionally, PMI will include the following during the grievance process:

- Use trained personnel to objectively evaluate all relevant evidence without prejudice of the facts at issue and free from conflicts of interest or bias for or against either party;
- Protect parties’ privacy by requiring a party’s written consent before using the party’s medical, psychological, or similar treatment records during a grievance process;
- Obtain the parties’ voluntary, written consent before using any kind of informal resolution process such as mediation or restorative justice, and not use an informal process where an employee allegedly sexually harassed a student;
- Apply a presumption of innocence so that PMI bears the burden of proof and standard of evidence is applied correctly;
- Use either the preponderance of evidence standard or the clear and convincing evidence standard;
- Ensure the decision-maker is not the same person as the investigator or the Title IX Coordinator;
- Hold a live hearing and allow cross-examination by party advisors;
- Protect all complainants from inappropriately being asked about prior sexual history;
- Send both parties a written determination regarding responsibility explaining how and why the decision-maker reached conclusions;
- Effectively implement remedies for a complainant if a respondent is found responsible for sexual harassment;
- Offer both parties an equal opportunity to appeal;
- Protect any individual, including complainants, respondents, and witnesses, from retaliation for reporting sexual harassment or participating (or refusing to participate) in any Title IX grievance process;
- Make all materials used to train Title IX personnel publicly available on the school’s website;
- Document and keep records of all sexual harassment reports and investigations.

The Title IX coordinator, including a designee with the same level of training as the Title IX Coordinator, shall be responsible for overseeing the reporting process, training, and initial investigation. Any person may report sex discrimination, including sexual harassment, in person, by mail, by telephone, webform, or by email, using the contact information listed for the Title IX Coordinator.

Report may be made at any time (including during non-business hours) by using the telephone number or email address, by webform, or by mail to the office address, listed for the Title IX Coordinator.

Supportive Measures

PMI offers free supportive measures to every alleged victim of sexual harassment. Supportive measures are individualized services to restore or preserve equal access to education, protect student and employee safety, or deter sexual harassment. Supportive measures are offered even if a complainant does not wish to initiate or participate in a grievance process. Every situation is unique, and individuals react to sexual harassment differently. Therefore, PMI gives complainants control over the school-level response that best meets their needs. PMI respects complainants' wishes and autonomy by giving them the clear choice to file a formal complaint, separate from the right to supportive measures. PMI also provides a fair and impartial grievance process for complainants, and protects complainants from being coerced or threatened into participating in a grievance process.

Additional Enforcement Information

The U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) investigates reports of unlawful harassment and discrimination, including sex-based harassment, in employment.

The U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR) investigates complaints of unlawful discrimination and harassment of students and employees in education programs or activities.

Personally Identifying Information

PMI will ensure that the Reporting Party's personally identifying information will not be included in any publicly available recordkeeping, including Clery Act reporting and disclosures such as the Annual Security Report and the daily crime log.

Personally identifying information is defined in Section 40002(a) of the Violence Against Women Acts of 1994 as individually identifying information for or about an individual, including information likely to disclose the location of a victim of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault or stalking, regardless of whether the information is encoded, encrypted, hashed or otherwise protected.

THE FAMILY EDUCATION RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT INFORMATIONAL GUIDELINES

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 protects the privacy of student education records. The Act defines an "eligible student" as a student who has reached 18 years of age or is attending an institution of postsecondary education. The Act defines "parent" to mean a parent of a student and includes a natural parent, a guardian, or an individual acting as a parent in the absence of a parent or a guardian. An educational agency or institution shall give full rights under the Act to either parent, unless the agency or institution has been provided with evidence that there is a court order, State statute, or legally binding document relating to such matters as divorce, separation, or custody that specifically revokes these rights. When a student becomes an eligible student (turns 18), the rights accorded to, and consent required of, parents transfer from the parents to the eligible student. Under FERPA, parents and eligible students have the following rights:

The right to inspect and review the student's education records within 45 days of Pima Medical Institute (PMI) receipt of a request for access. A parent or eligible student should submit to the Campus Director a written request identifying the record(s) the parent/eligible student wishes to inspect and review. The school official will make arrangements for access and notify the parent/eligible student of the time and place where the records may be inspected. If the parent/eligible student is logistically unable to inspect and review the records at that time, PMI will make other arrangements to ensure the parent/eligible student is able to inspect and review the requested records.

The right to request the amendment of the student's education records that the parent/eligible student believes is inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise in violation of the student's privacy rights under FERPA.

If a record is believed to be inaccurate, a parent/eligible student should submit a written statement to the Campus Director that clearly identifies the part of the record(s) in question and specify why it is believed to be inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise in violation of a student's privacy rights.

PMI will notify the parent/eligible student of the decision to amend or not amend the record within 30 days of receiving the parent's/eligible student's request for amendment. Should PMI decide not to amend the record as requested by the parent/eligible student, the parent/eligible student will be informed of their right to a hearing regarding the request for amendment and be provided with information regarding hearing procedures.

The right to provide written consent before Pima Medical Institute discloses personally identifiable information (PII) from the student's education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent. Exceptions that permit disclosure without student consent include the following:

- school officials with legitimate educational interests (persons employed by PMI in administrative, supervisory, academic or research, support staff positions including law enforcement unit personnel and health staff);
- persons or companies PMI has contracted with (such as an attorney, auditor, or collection agent);
- students serving on an official committee, such as a disciplinary or grievance committee or assisting another school official in performing his or her tasks; and
- (upon request) officials of another school in which a student intends to enroll.

A school official typically has a legitimate educational interest if the official needs to review an education record in order to fulfill his or her professional responsibilities for PMI.

The right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education concerning alleged failures by the Pima Medical Institute to comply with the requirements of FERPA. The name and address of the office that administers FERPA is:

Directory Information

FERPA permits public disclosure of directory information without the parent's/eligible student's consent unless the parent/eligible student has requested that directory information be withheld. Directory information is information contained in a student's education record that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed. FERPA requires each institution to define its directory items. PMI defines the following as directory information:

- Student name
- PMI email address
- Photograph
- Campus
- Field of study
- Dates of attendance
- Grade level
- Enrollment status
- Degrees
- Honors & awards

PMI does not publish a student directory. A student's directory information may be released to an inquirer, unless the student specifically requests that directory information be withheld. FERPA does not require that directory information be released. Parents or eligible students may elect to withhold directory information by completing and signing the Request to Withhold Directory Information form, which places the student record in a confidentiality hold status.

This form is available in the student services office. A request to withhold directory information is in effect permanently, even if the student is no longer enrolled at PMI. A request to withhold directory information results in the following:

- Student name and program information will be excluded from all printed public documents and other similar printed material, such as commencement programs;
- Enrollment and degree-awarded inquiries from third parties, including potential employers and insurance companies, will neither receive a confirmation of enrollment nor graduation; and
- No information will be released to any person(s) on the telephone or via email.

A student's request for withhold of directory information does not permit the student to be anonymous in the classroom (including an online classroom) nor to impede or be excluded from classroom communication. A student's request for withhold of directory information does not preclude the student from having a student identification (ID) number. The directory information withhold can be removed if the parent/eligible student submits a written request for removal.

Release of Nondirectory Information

Students may provide consent to release nondirectory information (financial and academic records) to designated third parties by completing a FERPA Release Consent in the student portal or by contacting the student services office. The release remains in effect until the consent is revoked in writing and the revocation is delivered to PMI.

COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT & COMPUTER SHARING

Copyright infringement is the act of exercising, without permission or legal authority, one or more of the exclusive rights granted to the copyright owner under section 106 of the Copyright Act (Title 17 of the United States Code). These rights include the right to reproduce or distribute a copyrighted work. In the file-sharing context, downloading, uploading, and/or sharing substantial parts of a copyrighted work, without authority or permission, constitutes an infringement.

Penalties for copyright infringement include civil and criminal penalties. In general, anyone found liable for civil copyright infringement may be ordered to pay either actual damages or "statutory" damages affixed at not less than \$750 and not more than \$30,000 per work infringed. For "willful" infringement, a court may award up to \$150,000 per work infringed. A court can, in its discretion, also assess costs and attorneys' fees. For details, see Title 17, United States Code, Sections 504, 505. Willful copyright infringement can also result in criminal penalties, including imprisonment of up to five years and fines of up to \$250,000 per offense.

Unauthorized Sharing

The Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) is a federal law that is designed to protect copyright holds from online theft, which is the unauthorized distribution of copyrighted material is the unlawful reproduction or distribution of others works. The act covers music, movies, text and anything that is copyrighted. These provisions are designed to reduce the illegal uploading and downloading or copyrighted works through peer-to-peer file sharing. Sample violations include:

- Forwarding, downloading and saving, or copying copyrighted material through any electronic or physical medium (e.g., email, text, thumb drive).
- Joining a file share network and downloading unauthorized copies of copyrighted material.

A list of legal alternative downloading options is available through the PMI website or through the Dean of Instruction.

PMI Computing Resources

Computing resources include all computers, related equipment, software, data, and local area networks for which the school is responsible as well as networks throughout the world to which the school provides computer access.

The computing resources of Pima Medical Institute (PMI) are intended to be used for its programs of instruction and research and to conduct the legitimate business of the school. All users must have proper authorization for the use of the computing resources. Users are responsible for complying with all legal and ethical guidelines of PMI computing resources. Users have a responsibility to respect the privacy, copyrights, and intellectual property rights of others. Use must be in accordance with school policy and applicable state and federal laws. Violations include but are not limited to the following:

The use of computing resources to:

- harass, threaten, or cause harm to individuals,
- interfere with the activities of others, and/or
- download or post material that is offensive, illegal, proprietary, and/or in violation of copyright laws.

In instances of copyright infringement or prohibited file sharing, PMI will take disciplinary action if there is evidence of one or more violations, which may include termination from the program and/or employment. If a complaint is received, Information Technology Services will disable network access for the listed device and attempt to identify the owner to inform them about the complaint. If the owner believes the complaint to be inaccurate, they will be given the opportunity to contest the finding when they meet with student services or their department.

Sanctions

Copyright infringement is the act of exercising, without permission or legal authority, one or more of the exclusive rights granted to the copyright owner under section 106 of the Copyright Act (Title 17 of the United States Code). These rights include the right to reproduce or distribute a copyrighted work. In the file-sharing context, downloading or uploading substantial parts of a copyrighted work, without authority or permission, constitutes an infringement. Penalties for copyright infringement include civil and criminal penalties. In general, anyone found liable for civil copyright infringement may be ordered to pay either actual damages or statutory damages affixed at not less than \$750 and not more than \$30,000 per work infringed. For willful infringement, a court may award up to \$150,000 per work infringed. A court can, in its discretion, also assess costs and attorneys' fees. For details, see Title 17, United States Code, Sections 504, 505. Willful copyright infringement can also result in criminal penalties, including imprisonment of up to five years and fines of up to \$250,000 per offense.

Students and faculty will receive an annual notice of this policy. The PMI Corporate Education Department, Regulatory Department, and Information Technology Department will periodically review this policy, the institution's plans for the unauthorized distribution of copyrighted material, and the legal alternatives for downloading. Students and faculty will then be notified of the results of the review.

CLERY ACT REPORTABLE CRIMES/DEFINITIONS

The following information comes from the Department of Education's Handbook for Campus Safety and Security Reporting (2016); Uniform Crime Reporting Handbook; Sex Offenses definitions from the National Incident-Based Reporting System Edition of the Uniform Crime Reporting Program; and definitions of domestic violence, dating violence and stalking adapted from the amendments made to the Violence Against Women Re-Authorization Act of 2013.

Hierarchy Rule

When counting multiple offenses, PMI uses the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Hierarchy Rule. This rule requires counting only the most serious offense when more than one offense was committed during a single incident.

Unfounded Crimes

Crimes that were "unfounded" are excluded from these statistics. Only sworn law enforcement can unfound a crime and unfounded crimes only include those that were investigated by law enforcement authorities and found to be false or baseless.

Criminal Offenses

Murder/Non-negligent Manslaughter: the willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another.

Manslaughter by Negligence: the killing of another person through gross negligence.

Sexual Assault (Sex Offenses): Actual or attempted sexual contact with another person without that person's consent.

Rape: The penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus, with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim. This offense includes the rape of both males and females.

Fondling: The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification, without the consent of the victim, includes instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his or her age or because of his or her temporary or permanent mental incapacity.

Incest: Sexual intercourse between persons who are related to each other within the degrees wherein marriage is prohibited by law.

Statutory Rape: Sexual intercourse with a person who is under the statutory age of consent.

Robbery: the taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.

Aggravated Assault: an unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault usually is accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.

Burglary: The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft.

Motor Vehicle Theft: The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle.

Arson: The willful or malicious burning or attempt to burn, with or without intent to defraud, a dwelling house, public building, motor vehicle or aircraft, personal property of another, etc.

Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Offenses

Dating Violence: Violence committed by a person who is or has been in a social relationship of a romantic or intimate nature with the victim. The existence of such a relationship shall be determined based on the reporting party's statement and with consideration of the length of the relationship, the type of relationship, and the frequency of interaction between the persons involved in the relationship. For the purposes of this definition, dating violence includes, but is not limited to, sexual or physical abuse or the threat of such abuse. Dating violence does not include acts covered under the definition of domestic violence. Any incident meeting this definition is considered a crime for purposes of Clery Act reporting.

Domestic Violence: A felony or misdemeanor crime of violence committed by a current or former spouse or intimate partner of the victim; by a person with whom the victim shares a child in common; by a person who

is cohabitating with, or has cohabitated with, the victim as a spouse or intimate partner; by a person similarly situated to a spouse of the victim under the domestic or family violence laws of the jurisdiction in which the crime of violence occurred; by any other person against an adult or youth victim who is protected from that person's acts under the domestic or family violence laws of the jurisdiction in which the crime of violence occurred.

Stalking: Engaging in a course of conduct directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person to fear for the person's safety or the safety of others; or suffer substantial emotional distress. For the purposes of this definition, *course of conduct* means two or more acts, including, but not limited to, acts in which the stalker directly, indirectly, or through third parties, by any action, method, device, or means, follows, monitors, observes, surveils, threatens, or communicates to or about a person, or interferes with a person's property. *Reasonable person* means a person under similar circumstances and with similar identities to the victim. *Substantial emotional distress* means significant mental suffering or anguish that may, but does not necessarily require medical or other professional treatment or counseling.

Sexual Assault: see under "Criminal Offenses" as primary Clery-reportable crimes.

Arrests and Referrals for Disciplinary Action

Weapon Law Violations: The violation of laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, sale, purchase, transportation, possession, concealment, or use of firearms, cutting instruments, explosives, incendiary devices or other deadly weapons. This classification encompasses weapons offenses that are regulatory in nature.

Drug Abuse Violations: Violation of laws prohibiting the production, distribution and/or use of certain controlled substances and the equipment or devices utilized in their preparation and/or use. The unlawful cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, purchase, use, possession, transportation or importation of any controlled drug or narcotic substance. Arrests for violations of state and local laws, specifically those relating to the unlawful possession, sale, use, growing, manufacturing and making of narcotic drugs.

Liquor Law Violations: The violation of state or local laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, sale, purchase, transportation, possession or use of alcoholic beverages, not including driving under the influence and drunkenness.

Hate Crimes

A hate crime is not a separate, distinct crime, but is the commission of a criminal offense, which was motivated by the offender's bias. If the facts of the case indicate that the offender was motivated to commit the offense because of his or her bias against the victim's race, religion, ethnicity, national origin, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability, the crime is classified as a hate crime.

Larceny-Theft: The unlawful taking, carrying, leading, or riding away of property from the possession or constructive possession of another. Constructive possession is the condition in which a person does not have physical custody or possession, but in a position to exercise dominion or control over a thing.

Destruction/Damage/Vandalism of Property: To willfully or maliciously destroy, damage, deface, or otherwise injure real or personal property without the consent of the owner or the person having custody or control of it.

Intimidation: To unlawfully place another person in reasonable fear of bodily harm through the use of threatening words and/or other conduct, but without displaying a weapon or subjecting the victim to actual physical attack.

Simple Assault: An unlawful physical attack by one person upon another where neither the offender displays a weapon, nor the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness.

The Annual Campus Safety and Security Report Availability

The following communication will be sent annually, prior to October 1st, via school e-mail to all students and staff.

Pima Medical Institute's annual security report is now available. This report is required by federal law and contains policy statements and crime statistics for the school. The policy statements address the school's policies, procedures and programs concerning safety and security.

Three years' worth of statistics are included for certain types of crimes that were reported to have occurred on campus, in or on off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by the school and on public property within or immediately adjacent to the campus. Notification, Evacuation, Health, Safety and Security information can be found in this report. This report is available on the school website, www.pmi.edu and a printed copy of the report is available at your campus' front desk upon request.
