### **Clinical Facility / Externship Requirements**

Students may be required to travel greater than 60 miles for their clinical externship and may be required to travel out of state.

Students may be required to train during evening and/or weekend shifts for their clinical rotations.

### **Additional Fees**

Additional out of pocket costs can range from \$200.00 to more than \$1,000.00 in fees. All Associate Degree Radiography programs require a background check, drug screen, vaccinations and/or titers, health insurance, and CPR certification. Depending on the clinical facility, students may also be required to register with a clinical reporting database, purchase hospital required identification badges, and/or obtain additional background checks. Clinical travel expense considerations include items that are not included in the tuition or fees but are expenses that may come up during clinical experiences. The actual cost of these potential expenses will vary depending on the student's primary residence, the location of the assigned clinical site, and the requirements of the clinical site. Expenses may include: travel to clinical site, lodging, meals, transportation while at site, uniforms, and laterality markers. Graduates can expect there to be costs associated with registering for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) certification exam and applying for state licensure.
